

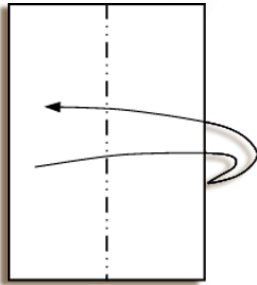

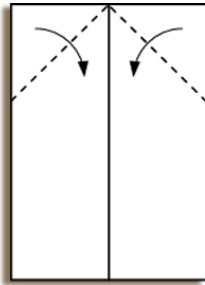
Paper Jet Airplane

Make a paper jet airplane by following these instructions.

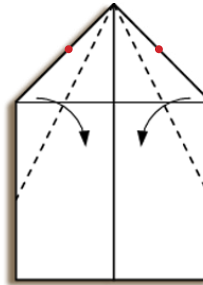
Hint: When folding make sure your folds are tight and sharp. You can do this by running your thumb nail or a spoon down each fold. Your plane will fly better.



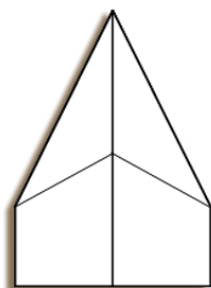
1. Fold your paper in half long-ways (Some people call it a hotdog fold)



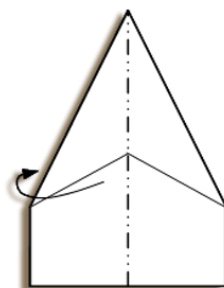
2. Fold down the two top corners till they touch the center fold you made in step one.



3. Fold down the two edges with the red dots on them until they line up with the same center fold.



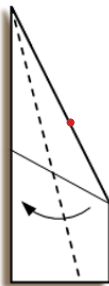
4. Your plane should look alot like this.



5. Fold the left half of your plane back under the other side



6. Your plane should look alot like this.



6. Now fold down just this top side so that the edge with the dot lines up with the left edge that is the bottom. Flip it over and do the same on the other side.



7. Once both sides are folded down, those will be your wings and it will look like this.



8. Now, straighten the wings by pulling them up and even with each other. Your plane is ready to fly. The part on the bottom (where the red dot is) is your handle. As throw it, keep the pointed nose up just a little more than the tail.

Before flying, read what's in the box that says "Fly safe."

Fly safe!

Even though your airplane is only made of paper, it can still hurt someone or break things. Every one who flies a plane must remember special rules of flying.

Paper plane pilots safety rules:

- Never throw your airplane at someone, especially their face. This could hurt someone very seriously.
- Do not fly your plane in the house unless you have permission for your parents or an adult. The plane could knock over some valuable things and break them.
- When you go back to school, don't take your plane unless you have permission from your teacher before you bring it with you.
